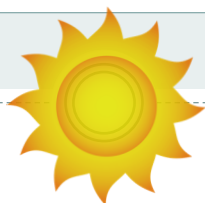

Archie Vol. 4 by Mark Waid

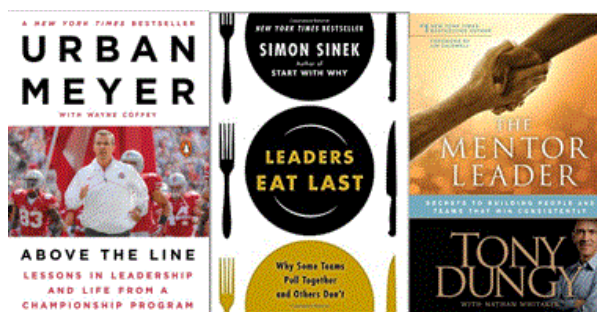
The fourth installment of the new run of *Archie* comics is by far the most intense volume so far, and your favorite Riverdale teens might not all make it out alive.
